- 13 Any person who drives any vehicle in a manner inconsistent
- 14 with the exercise of due and diligent care normally
- 15 exercised by a reasonably prudent person under similar
- 16 circumstances and where such operation of a motor vehicle

- 2 is guilty of careless driving.
