A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; establishing the
2 offense of involuntary termination of pregnancy; imposing a
3 penalty; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 6-2-109 is created to read:

8

9 **6-2-109. Involuntary termination of pregnancy;**
10 **penalty.**

12 Whoever willfully kills any pregnant woman knowing that the
13 woman is pregnant, and thereby causes the involuntary
14 termination of the woman's pregnancy without a live birth,
15 is guilty of involuntary termination of pregnancy, and in
16 addition to any penalty imposed for the homicide of the

1 woman shall be imprisoned in the penitentiary for not less
2 than twenty (20) years and not more than life.

3

4 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2009.
