- 1 AN ACT relating to higher education matching funds
- 2 programs; modifying time limitations for eligible
- 3 donations; eliminating stated donation period for matching
- 4 funds eligibility; repealing provisions for reversion of
- 5 funds; repealing executed provisions; and providing for an
- 6 effective date.
