1	(b) Any adult may be adopted, regardless of his
2	residence within or outside of this state at the time the
3	<pre>petition is filed, provided:</pre>

5	(i) The adult resided with the adopting parent
6	when the adult was a child;
7	
8	(ii) The adopting parent was a stepparent,
9	grandparent or other blood relative, foster parent or legal
10	guardian who participated in the raising of the adult when
11	the adult was a child; and

13	(iii) The adult files a consent to the adoption
14	with the court.

16	1-22-113. Petition for adoption of an adult; consent
17	required.

19	When a petition to adopt an adult is filed a copy of the
20	petition together with a summons issued as in other civil
21	actions under Rule 4 of the Wyoming Rules of Civil
22	Procedure shall be served on the adult. If the adult
23	objects to adoption by the petitioner the petition shall be
24	dismissed. When the consent of the adult is given, the
