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2	21-6-301. Definitions.
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4	(a) As used in this article:
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6	(i) "County committee" means the county planning
7	committee for the consolidation of school districts in
8	accordance with this article;
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10	(ii) "Plan of consolidation" means a plan which
11	would place all the territory of a county into one (1)
12	unified school district with boundaries identical to those
13	of the county in which it is located;
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15	(iii) "State committee" means as defined in W.S.
16	21-6-202(a)(ii);
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18	(iv) "Unified school district" means as defined
19	in W.S. 21-6-202(a)(iv).
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21	21-6-302. County planning committees; membership;
22	duties.
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1 (a) By September 1, 2009, the board of trustees of

2 each school district within each county comprised of more

3 than one (1) school district shall elect one (1) registered

4 voter from each school district to be a member of a county

5 committee to review the consolidation of the school

6 districts within that county. In those counties with five

7 (5) or less districts, two (2) members shall be elected

8 from each district.

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10 (b) Each member of the district boundary board of

11 each county or counties established under W.S. 21-6-203

12 shall be an ex officio member of the county committee

13 without voting privileges.

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15 (c) Each county planning committee shall:

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17 (i) Prepare and submit to the state committee

18 before September 1, 2010, a report on consolidation and a

19 plan of reorganization conforming to the criteria and

20 procedures specified in this article for the reorganization

21 of school districts within the county, to be effective July

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22 1, 2011;

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1 (ii) Hold at least one (1) public hearing within 2 the county on its proposal for the reorganization plan. 3 Notice of each hearing shall be published in a newspaper of 4 general circulation in the county at least once each week 5 for the two (2) week period immediately preceding the time set for the hearing. The notice shall contain a statement 6 of the time and place of the hearing and a brief summary of 7 its purpose. In addition, at least ten (10) days and not 8 9 more than fourteen (14) days before the hearing, a copy of the notice shall be sent to each school district trustee 10 11 residing in the area involved in the hearing; 12 13 (iii) Include in the report to the state 14 committee its determination of the feasibility of 15 consolidation, necessary incentives to encourage voluntary consolidation and obstacles to consolidation. This portion 16 17 of the report shall also be submitted by the county committee to members of the legislature; 18

20 (iv) The report shall include the proposed 21 consolidation plan and the following:

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23 (A) Recommendations on the location 24 schools, the utilization of existing buildings, allocation

of existing indebtedness, the employment of existing 1 2 personnel and the transportation requirements under the 3 proposed plan for the organization of the reorganized 4 district, together with the time period under 5 recommendations are to be accomplished; 6 7 A summary of the reasons for the plan; (B) 8 9 (C) A record of all hearings; 10 11 (D) A summary of any anticipated 12 modifications to educational programs; 13 14 (E) The number of trustees and the manner of trustee selection for a countywide unified school 15 16 district; 17 (F) The proposed time schedule for school 18 district reorganization under the plan; 19 20 21 (G) The extent to which consolidation may 22 result in a reduction in total federal revenues available to the reorganized district as compared with that available 23 24 to all existing districts within the county. 1 shall include recommendations to minimize the impact of

2 reorganization on the availability of federal revenue; and

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4 (H) Other reports, records and materials as

5 the county committee or the state committee deems

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8 21-6-303. Powers and duties of state committee.

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10 (a) The state committee shall:

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12 (i) Aid the several county committees in

13 carrying out this article by furnishing state department of

14 education staff assistance as authorized by the state

15 superintendent, and providing plans of procedure,

16 standards, data, maps and other information and services to

17 the county committees as necessary to carry out the

18 purposes of this article;

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20 (ii) By October 1, 2009, appoint a county

21 committee in any county in which a county committee is not

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22 elected as required by this article;

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1 (iii) By October 1, 2010, develop a plan for the

2 reorganization of the school districts within a county for

3 which a plan has not been submitted in accordance with this

4 article. The plan shall conform to the criteria and

5 procedures specified under W.S. 21-6-302 for implementation

6 on July 1, 2011.

(b) Within sixty (60) days of the date of receipt, 8 9 review the submitted plan for reorganization and approve or reject the submitted plan with reasons for rejection and 10 11 recommendations for making the plan acceptable. A plan shall be rejected only if it fails to comply with the 12 provisions of this article. If a plan is rejected, a 13 14 county committee may resubmit a modified plan as often as necessary. Upon plan approval, the state committee shall 15 make an order establishing the reorganized, countywide 16 17 school district according to the approved plan organization, effective July 1, 2011. The order is the 18 19 final administrative determination and shall be filed with 20 the county clerk of the appropriate county prior to July 1, 21 2011. The order shall be effective and binding on July 1, 2011. 22 The final administrative action of the state 23 committee shall be appealable from the date of filing with

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Section 2. The reorganization plans developed and submitted under section 1 of this act shall be incorporated into the 2010 recalibration of the education resource block grant model undertaken pursuant to W.S. 21-13-309(t) and shall guide school finance recommendations submitted to the 2011 legislature.

Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2009.
