4 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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6 **Section 1.** W.S. 36-5-105(c) is amended to read:

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- 8 36-5-105. Criteria for leasing; preferences;
- 9 assignments, subleases or contracts; lands taken for war
- 10 purposes; mineral lands excepted; agricultural lands.

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- 12 (c) An applicant who is the holder of an expiring
- 13 lease, and has paid the rental when due, and has not
- 14 violated the provisions of the lease, and is qualified
- 15 under the provisions of W.S. 36-5-101, shall have a
- 16 preferred right to renew such lease by meeting the highest

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1	bid offered by another qualified applicant who has actual
2	and necessary use for the land and available forage and
3	whose bid is <del>based on the fair market value using the</del>
4	formula developed by the board pursuant to W.S.
5	36-5-101(b), not less than the minimum fair market value as
6	determined by the board for the same or a similar use of
7	land. using the formula developed pursuant to W.S.
8	36-5-101(b) and not more than the maximum fair market value
9	as determined by the board based on the following:
10	
11	(i) The private land lease rate per animal unit
12	for the previous year for the national agricultural
13	statistics district or the county in Wyoming within which
14	the land is located; and
15	
16	(ii) An adjustment to reasonably reflect the
17	contributions of improvements typically provided as a part
18	of a private land grazing lease rate.
19	
20	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2009.
