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7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 9 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-13-335(b)(intro), by creating new
- 10 paragraphs (iii) and (iv) and (f) is amended to read:

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- 12 21-13-335. Supplemental financial assistance program
- 13 for instructional facilitators and instructional coaches.

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- 15 (b) Each school district may apply to the department
- 16 of education for financial assistance under this section on

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or before April 15 of the school year immediately preceding 1 2 year for which financial assistance the school 3 requested. Application shall be on a form and in a manner 4 prescribed by the department and application review and 5 selection shall be in accordance with the process established by department rule 6 and regulation, with priority given to programs incorporating requirements 7 specified under paragraph (iv) of this subsection. 8 9 minimum, the application shall include documentation of the 10 following program components: 11 (iii) Evidence that financial assistance 12 13 available under this section will be used to employ 14 facilitators with at least five (5) years of classroom teaching experience and holding a masters degree or holding 15 national certification by the national board for 16 17 professional teaching standards; 18 19 (iv) A system for identifying and evaluating 20 instructor performance as measured by student achievement 21 based upon an established achievement gains model, which 22 provides programs designed to improve instructor skills and knowledge through continuous learning and sustained support 23

and which requires development of improvement strategies

1 <u>aligned</u> with overall school and student academic

2 <u>improvement plans.</u>

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4 Each district shall report to the department of 5 education on expenditures of amounts distributed under this section together with additional information required by 6 department on instructional facilitation strategies 7 employed by the district, employment of facilitators 8 9 meeting criteria specified under paragraph (b)(iii) of this section, the impact of facilitation on student performance 10 and an evaluation of the effectiveness of the facilitation 11 strategies employed by the recipient district as documented 12 13 by actual data. The department shall compile information reported by districts under this subsection and 14 report the compilation to the joint education interim 15 committee. Based upon this compilation and upon actual 16 data substantiating the impact of facilitation strategies 17 on instructor performance and student achievement, the 18 department shall provide recommendations to the committee 19 20 on future program structure and funding in sufficient time 21 to guide recalibration of the education resource block grant model as required under W.S. 21-13-309(t) for 22 23 consideration by the 2011 legislature.
