(c) Notwithstanding subsection (a) of this section, no more than one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) of the funds shall be expended under this act until one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) in pledges have been made to aid in the operation and maintenance of the facility and pursuant to W.S. 36-8-304 and the joint powers board has

1 entered into a lease agreement with the department of state

16 committee on the progress of the construction and the

17 construction related activities of the discovery center
