1	(a) Criminal history record information shall be
2	disseminated by criminal justice agencies in this state,
3	whether directly or through any intermediary, only to:

5	(xx) The Wyoming retirement system.

10	(a) The following persons shall be required to submit
11	to fingerprinting in order to obtain state and national
12	criminal history record information:

14	(xiii) Wyoming retirement system employees or
15	applicants for employment who have access to confidential

19	compensation of director, consulting actuary and
20	assistants; director designated secretary; compensation of

23	(a) The board shall employ a director and a
24	consulting actuary and other professional and clerical

assistants necessary for the administration of 1 the 2 retirement system and the Wyoming deferred compensation 3 program established under W.S. 9-3-501 through 9-3-508. The 4 compensation of employees shall be fixed by the board, 5 subject to confirmation and approval by the personnel division and together with all other necessary expenses of 6 the board shall be paid by vouchers drawn on the state 7 treasurer of Wyoming. The director shall also serve, 8 9 without additional compensation, as secretary of the board. 10 The board shall have the authority to obtain the financial 11 and criminal background history of an employee or employment applicant of the Wyoming retirement system in 12 13 accordance with W.S. 7-19-106 and 7-19-201. 14 15 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2009. 16
