## A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to workforce services; amending department
- 2 of workforce services confidentiality provisions; revising
- 3 the membership of and transferring oversight of the
- 4 governor's council for employment and rehabilitation of the
- 5 handicapped as specified; transferring the displaced worker
- 6 and education program to the department of workforce
- 7 services; updating the entities to be consulted in
- 8 preparing the displaced worker and education statewide
- 9 plan; and providing for an effective date.

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11 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 13 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-2-2607(a), 27-1-110, 27-1-111,
- 14 27-1-112, 27-13-101(a)(iv) and 27-13-102(a)(intro) are
- 15 amended to read:

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1	9-2-2607. Confidentiality of information; disclosure;
2	reimbursement.

4	(a) Except as otherwise provided, information
5	maintained pursuant to this article shall not be disclosed
6	in a manner which reveals the identity of the employing
7	unit or the individual. The confidentiality limitations of
8	this section do not apply to transfers of information $\underline{to}$
9	the employing unit or the individual or between the
10	divisions of the department of workforce services so long
11	as the transfer of information is not restricted by federal
12	law, rule or contract. Any employee of the requesting
13	department or agency who discloses information outside of
14	the department in violation of federal or state law may be
15	terminated without progressive discipline.

17	27-1-110. State rehabilitation council; membership;
18	chairman.

20	(a) There is established a permanent council within
21	the department of employment workforce services to be known
22	as the Wyoming governor's <del>council for employment and</del>
23	rehabilitation of the handicapped state rehabilitation

24  $\underline{\text{council}}$ , to consist of: at least twelve (12) members

1	appointed by the governor. At least three (3) members of
2	the council shall have handicapping conditions, and at
3	least three (3) members shall be representative of private
4	employers or employer's organizations. No member shall be a
5	state employee.

7	(i) At least one (1) representative of the
8	statewide independent living council;
9	
10	(ii) At least one (1) representative of a parent
11	training and information center;
12	
13	(iii) At least one (1) representative of the
14	<pre>client assistance program;</pre>
15	
16	(iv) At least one (1) vocational rehabilitative
17	<pre>counselor;</pre>
18	
19	(v) At least one (1) representative of community
20	rehabilitation program service providers;
21	
22	(vi) Four (4) representatives of business,
23	industry and labor;

1	(vii) Representatives of disability advocacy
2	groups;
3	
4	(viii) Current or former applicants of
5	vocational rehabilitation services;
6	
7	(ix) The administrator of the division of
8	vocational rehabilitation;
9	
10	(x) At least one (1) representative of the
11	department of education;
12	
13	(xi) At least one (1) representative of the
14	state workforce investment board.

16	(b) The director of the department of workforce
17	services shall be an ex officio, nonvoting member of the
18	state rehabilitation council.
19	
20	(c) A majority of council members shall be persons
21	who are:

23	(i) Individuals with disabilities;

1 (ii) Not employed by the division of vocational 2 rehabilitation. 3 (d) One (1) of the members shall be elected chairman 4 5 by the members of the council. The appointive members shall hold office for the term specified. The council shall be 6 nonpartisan. The governor may remove any council member as 7 provided in W.S. 9-1-202. 8 9 27-1-111. Duties of council and department. 10 11 The department of employment workforce services, with 12 13 advice of the council, shall carry on a continuing program employment of physically, mentally, 14 promote the emotionally and otherwise handicapped persons by creating 15 statewide interest in the rehabilitation and employment of 16 17 handicapped and by obtaining and maintaining cooperation from all public and private 18 groups individuals in the field. The council shall work in 19

21 the handicapped in order to more effectively carry out the

purposes of this act.
