- 13 ROYALTY ON PRODUCTION OF ELECTRICITY

15 **37-16-301.** Imposition; administration.

16

1 (a) There is imposed in this state a royalty fee on

2 each kilowatt hour produced from any wind turbine. The

3 royalty fee shall be equal to three percent (3%) of the

4 sales price received by the producer per kilowatt hour, or

5 portion thereof, produced in this state. The royalty shall

6 be imposed upon the production of any electricity generated

7 for sale or trade.

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9 (b) The public service commission shall enforce the

10 provisions of this article. The commission shall promulgate

11 rules and regulations necessary for the implementation and

12 enforcement of this article.

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14 (c) No royalty shall be imposed upon electricity

15 which is produced for the personal consumption of the

16 producer.

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18 37-16-302. Compliance; collection procedures.

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20 (a) Returns and reports. Any person producing

21 electricity in this state shall report the amount of

22 kilowatt hours produced and sold and the sales price

23 received therefore on or before February 1 of the year

1 immediately following the year in which the electricity was

produced. 2

Payment. Any person owing a royalty under this 4 (b)

5 article shall pay the royalty once each year on or before

February 1 of the year immediately following the year in 6

which the electricity was produced. The royalty shall be 7

collected by the public service commission. 8

10 Interest at an annual rate equal to (C) Interest.

the average prime interest rate as determined by the state

treasurer during the preceding fiscal year plus four 12

13 percent (4%) shall be added to all delinquent royalties

14 under this article. To determine the average prime

interest rate, the state treasurer shall average the prime 15

interest rate for at least seventy-five percent (75%) of 16

17 the thirty (30) largest banks in the United States.

interest rate on delinquent royalties shall be adjusted on 18

January 1 of each year following the year in which the 19

royalties first became delinquent. In no instance shall 20

21 the delinquent royalty rate be less than twelve percent

22 (12%) nor greater than eighteen percent (18%).

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24 (d) Penalties. The following shall apply:

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2 (i) If any person fails to make or file a return 3 and remit the royalty as required by this section the 4 commission shall impose a penalty of five percent (5%) of 5 the royalties due for each thirty (30) day period, or fraction thereof, elapsing between the due date of the 6 return and the date filed, unless the person for good cause 7 obtains from the commission an extension of time for filing 8 9 prior to the due date for filing. In no event shall the 10 total penalty imposed by this subsection exceed twenty-five 11 percent (25%) of the royalty due. The commission, for good cause, may waive a penalty imposed for failure to file a 12 13 return for any one (1) calendar year, provided that:

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15 (A) The return was filed within five (5)
16 business days following the due date, including an approved
17 extension period; and

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19 (B) The person owing the royalty requests
20 the waiver in writing within fifteen (15) days after the
21 return was filed, setting forth the reasons for the late
22 filing.

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23

1 (ii) If any part of a royalty deficiency is due

2 to negligence or intentional disregard of rules and

3 regulations there shall be added a penalty of five percent

4 (5%) of the amount of the deficiency plus interest as

5 provided by subsection (c) of this section. The royalties,

6 penalty and interest shall be paid within ten (10) days

7 after receipt of notice and demand by the commission;

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9 (iii) Royalties due together with interest,

10 penalties and costs shall be collectible by the commission

11 by appropriate judicial proceedings;

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13 (iv) The commission may credit or waive

14 penalties imposed by this section as part of a settlement

15 or for any other good cause.

16

17 (e) Liens. Any delinquent royalty is a lien upon the

18 property of any owner from and after the time the royalty

19 is due until the royalty is paid. The lien shall have

20 preference over all liens except any valid mortgage or

21 other liens of record filed or recorded prior to the date

22 the royalty became due.

24 **37-16-303.** Distribution.

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2 The proceeds from the royalty imposed by this article shall

3 be deposited in the general fund.

4

5 **Section 2.** The royalty imposed by this act shall not 6 be effective unless and until the federal Bureau of Land

7 Management imposes a user fee on the placement of any wind

8 turbine on federal land and the user fee is greater than

9 five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per wind turbine. If the

10 federal government imposes a user fee as provided by this

11 section and the governor certifies that fact to the

12 department of revenue, then January 1 of the year

13 immediately following such imposition and notification, the

14 royalty imposed by this act shall become effective.

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16 Section 3. This act is effective January 1, 2010.
