A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming business council; providing
2 additional reporting requirements for the annual report;
3 providing for a report from the Wyoming council for women's
4 issues; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-12-112(a)(intro), (ii) by creating
9 a new subparagraph (E) and by creating new paragraphs (vii)
10 through (ix) and 9-12-501 by creating a new subsection (c)
11 are amended to read:

13 **9-12-112. Annual report and budget.**

14

15 (a) The council shall submit an annual report in the
16 manner provided by W.S. 9-2-1014 and using the benchmarks

1 prescribed in this act. In addition to the requirements of
2 W.S. 9-2-1014, using the most recent data available,
3 included within the annual report shall be:

4
5 (ii) A summary of the total investments made by
6 the council under the Wyoming partnership challenge loan
7 program, article 3 of this chapter, including:

8
9 (E) A survey of each loan or grant
10 recipient detailing the number of jobs directly created or
11 retained including occupational and salary information and
12 aggregate data summarizing the demographic information of
13 newly hired employees.

14
15 (vii) A summary of the grants, funds and loans
16 from each program administered by the council using
17 reporting elements under paragraph (a)(ii) of this section
18 unless otherwise provided by statute;

20 (viii) A report of the recommendations of the
21 Wyoming council for women's issues pursuant to W.S.
22 9-12-501(c);

1 (ix) The results of the performance measures
2 identified in the council's business plan.

3
4 **9-12-501. Creation; areas of attention.**

5
6 (c) On or before July 15 of each year the council
7 shall submit a written report on its activities under this
8 section, including any recommendations, to the minerals,
9 business and economic development interim committee.

11 **Section 2.** 1998 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 6,
12 Section 1(d)(i)(A)(II) and (iii) by creating a new
13 subparagraph (D) is amended to read:

17 (d) The Wyoming business council shall
18 measure the effectiveness of this act in
19 submitting its annual report pursuant to W.S.
20 9-12-112 using benchmarks which include:

22 (i) Operational benchmarks:

5 created, lost or retained and capital investment
6 from recruited or retained companies, including:

8 (1) Occupations;

10 (2) Starting wage
11 amounts;

16 (4) Industrial sectors.

18 (iii) Quality of life benchmarks:

19
20 (D) Percent of the grantees with
21 health insurance for employees.

1 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon
2 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
3 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
4 Constitution.
