There is created an account known as the "federal 1 (a) natural resource policy account." Funds within the account 2 may be expended by the governor on behalf of the state of 3 Wyoming and its local governments, to take any of the 4 5 actions specified in this subsection in response to federal land, water, air, mineral and other natural resource 6 policies which may affect the tax base of the state, 7 wildlife management, state species, recreation, private 8 9 property rights, water rights or leasehold rights. Funds 10 also may be expended for preparing and participating in 11 environmental impact statements and environmental assessments, including analysis of economic or social and 12 natural or physical environmental effects on the human 13 The governor may expend funds from the 14 environment. federal natural resource policy account for: 15

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(i) Participation of the state, a state agency,
or a county or a conservation district as a joint lead
agency to prepare an environmental impact statement in
accordance with regulations promulgated by the federal
council on environmental quality;

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23 (ii) Participation of the state, a state agency,
24 or a conservation district as a cooperating

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5	(vi) Participation in the implementation of

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9	(c) In the expenditure of funds from the federal
10	natural resources policy account pursuant to this section,
11	preference shall be given to those funding requests that
12	enhance the internal capacity of a state agency or county
13	to participate in federal natural resource policy matters.
