3	v. Hayes, 526 F.3d 674, (10 th Cir., 2008); providing

6	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
7	
8	Section 1. W.S. 6-2-501(b) and by creating a new
9	subsection (g) is amended to read:
10	
11	6-2-501. Simple assault; battery; penalties.

13	(b) A person is guilty of battery if he unlawfully
14	touches another in a rude, insolent or angry manner or
15	that intentionally, knowingly or recklessly causes bodily
16	injury <u>. to another</u> .

1	(g) A person is guilty of an unlawful touching if he
2	touches another person in a rude, insolent or angry manner
3	without intentionally using sufficient physical force to
4	cause bodily injury to another. An unlawful touching under
5	this subsection is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of
6	not more than seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00).
7	
8	Section 2. The Wyoming legislature, cognizant of the

9 decision of the United State Court of Appeals for the 10th 10 Circuit in United States v. Hayes, 526 F.3d 674, (10th Cir., 11 2008), creates the offense of unlawful touching in W.S. 12 6-2-501(g), to clarify the elements of the offense of 13 simple battery for purposes of federal law, as addressed in 14 the court's decision.
