Mobile barber shops and salons.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to mobile barber shops and salons;
2 providing for the licensure of a mobile barber shop or
3 salon; providing a definition; establishing that a salon
4 can include a mobile barbershop; and providing for an
5 effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 33-7-108 and 33-12-120(a)(xvi) are
10 amended to read:

11

12 **33-7-108. Shop license; barber school license; fee;
13 renewal; application; inspection fees; nontransferable.**

14

15 (a) No person, association, partnership or
16 corporation shall operate or conduct a barbershop, mobile

1 shop or barber school without a valid, unexpired license.
2 Licenses shall be issued by the secretary of the board of
3 barber examiners or the board's designee. The annual
4 license fee shall be set by the board pursuant to W.S.
5 33-1-201 for each shop or school, payable in advance, but
6 if not paid on or before July 31 of each year, a late fee
7 set by board rule and regulation shall be assessed. The
8 licenses shall be conspicuously displayed at all times, and
9 no license shall be issued until all sanitary regulations
10 required by W.S. 33-7-101 through 33-7-211 or prescribed by
11 the board have been complied with. Applications for new
12 shops, mobile shops or schools or for shops or schools
13 changing locations shall be made in writing on forms
14 furnished by the board, and shall contain information
15 required by the board. An inspection fee for a new shop,
16 mobile shop or school or for a shop or school changing
17 location shall be set by the board pursuant to W.S.
18 33-1-201. A shop, mobile shop or school license is not
19 transferable.

21 (b) Registered barbers, cosmetologists, manicurists
22 or nail technicians, estheticians and hair stylists
23 licensed under W.S. 33-12-119 through 33-12-140 may engage
24 in the practice for which they are licensed in the same

1 shop or a mobile shop if the shop is licensed under
2 subsection (a) of this section and under W.S. 33-12-119
3 through 33-12-140.

4

5 (c) As used in this chapter, "mobile shop" means a
6 facility that is readily movable and where barbering,
7 cosmetology or both are practiced other than at a fixed
8 location.

9

10 **33-12-120. Definitions.**

11

12 (a) As used in this act:

13

14 (xvi) "Salon" means any place licensed under
15 this act in which cosmetology is practiced and can include
16 a mobile shop as defined in W.S. 33-7-108(c);

17

18 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2009.
