- 8 **Section 1.** W.S. 18-2-101(a)(vi), (viii) and by
- 9 creating a new paragraph (ix) is amended to read:

11 **18-2-101.** General powers.

- 13 (a) Each organized county in the state is a body
- 14 corporate and politic. The powers of the county shall be
- 15 exercised by a board of county commissioners which may:

1 (vi) Establish a surface water drainage system,

2 utilities and drainage management; and

(viii) Declare and abate nuisances which the 4 5 commission determines to be a threat to health or safety as provided in W.S. 18-2-115. No person shall create, 6 continue or permit nuisances to exist in violation of a 7 final order issued pursuant to W.S. 18-2-115. 8 9 resolution passed by a board of county commissioners 10 pursuant to this paragraph is enforceable, in addition to 11 other remedies provided by law, by injunction, mandamus or Whoever fails to comply with a final order 12 abatement. 13 shall be assessed a civil penalty of up to one hundred 14 dollars (\$100.00) per day for each day the violation continues. No resolution issued pursuant to this paragraph 15 shall regulate any permitted industrial facility or oil 16 17 and gas or mining operations necessary to the extraction, production or exploration of the mineral resources. 18 Nothing in this paragraph shall be construed to impair or 19 modify any rights afforded to farm or ranch operations 20 21 pursuant to the Wyoming Right to Farm and Ranch Act; - and

23 (ix) Through resolution prohibit or limit
24 smoking in public places in the county. Any regulation by

municipality if it is at least as restrictive as the county
restrictions or if the county commissioners do not regulate
smoking in the county.
