Cruelty to animals-minimum care.

for

1	AN ACT relating to animal cruelty; providing a standard for
2	minimum care; providing a definition; and providing for an
3	effective date.

5	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
6	
7	Section 1. W.S. 6-3-203(b) is amended to read:
8	
9	6-3-203. Cruelty to animals; penalties; limitation on
10	manner of destruction.
11	
12	(b) A person commits cruelty to animals if he has the
13	charge and custody of any animal and unnecessarily fails to
14	provide it with the proper food, drink or protection from
15	the weather, minimum care or cruelly abandons the animal
16	or in the case of immediate, obvious, serious illness or

1	injury, fails to provide the animal with appropriate care.
2	For purposes of this subsection:
3	
4	(i) "Companion animal" means an animal normally
5	maintained in or near the residence of its owner or care
6	giver who is treated as a pet;
7	
8	(ii) "Minimum care" means care sufficient to
9	preserve the health and well-being of an animal and, except
10	for emergencies or circumstances beyond the reasonable
11	control of the owner, includes, but is not limited to, the
12	following requirements:
13	
14	(A) Food of sufficient quantity and quality
15	to allow for normal growth or maintenance of body weight;
16	
17	(B) Open or adequate access to potable
18	water of a drinkable temperature in sufficient quantity to
19	satisfy the animal's needs;
20	
21	(C) Veterinary care deemed necessary by a
22	reasonably prudent person to relieve distress from injury,
23	neglect or disease;

1	(D) Adequate protection from the elements
2	and weather conditions suitable for the age, species and
3	physical condition of the animal so as to maintain the
4	animal in a state of good health. For companion animals
5	this includes access to a barn, house or other enclosed
6	structure sufficient to protect the animal from wind, rain,
7	snow or sun and which has adequate bedding to protect
8	against cold and dampness;
9	
10	(E) For companion animals, continuous
11	access to an area:
12	
13	(I) With air temperature suitable for
14	the health of the animal;
15	
16	(II) With adequate ventilation;
17	
18	(III) With regular diurnal lighting
19	cycles of either natural or artificial light;
20	
21	(IV) Kept reasonably clean and free
22	from excess waste or other contaminants that could affect
23	the animal's health; and
24	

1	(V) With adequate space for exercise
2	necessary for the health of the animal. Inadequate space
3	may be indicated by evidence of debility, stress or
4	abnormal behavior patterns.
5	
6	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2009.
