2	employer based child care facilities who do not comply with
3	W.S. 14-4-101 through 14-4-111 shall provide notice to
4	their employees that their child care facility is not
5	certified. The certifying authority, as defined by W.S.
6	14-4-101(a)(v), may inspect an employer based child care
7	facility if it receives notice, or has reason to believe,
8	that the facility is being operated so as to place the
9	life, health or safety of a minor child in imminent danger.
