A JOINT RESOLUTION proposing to amend the Wyoming
 Constitution by amending the classes of property for
 property taxation purposes by authorizing the legislature
 to limit the amount of property tax increase.

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BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING,
two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting
separately, concurring therein:

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Section 1. The following proposal to amend Wyoming Constitution, Article 15, Section 11 by creating a new subsection (e) is proposed for submission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the next general election for approval or rejection to become valid as a part of the Constitution if ratified by a majority of the electors at the election:

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15	Section 2. That the Secretary of State shall endorse
16	the following statement on the proposed amendment:
17	The adoption of this amendment will allow the legislature
18	to determine the maximum amount of any property tax that
19	can be collected and prescribe restrictions upon the
20	increase of the rate of taxation or assessment for all
21	classes of property.
