A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to judicial retirement; repealing mandatory
2 retirement age; making the act contingent upon passage of a
3 constitutional amendment as specified; and providing for an
4 effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 5-1-106(a)(intro) is amended to read:

9

10 **5-1-106. Retirement of judges of the supreme court or**
11 **district courts; pension; assignment of retired judges.**

13 (a) ~~A judge of the supreme court or district courts~~
14 ~~shall retire when he attains the age of seventy (70) years.~~

15 A judge is eligible for retirement when he has served as a
16 judge of the supreme court, a district court or both for:

2 **Section 2.** This act is effective only if the electors
3 adopt a constitutional amendment at the 2010 general
4 election repealing any mandatory retirement age for
5 justices and judges, as provided in 2010 House Joint
6 Resolution 4.

7

8 **Section 3.** Subject to section 2 of this act, this act
9 is effective upon certification of the election results of
10 the 2010 general election.
