AN ACT relating to insurance; providing a definition of normal wear and tear as it applies to service contracts; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 26-49-102(a)(ix) is amended to read:

26-49-102. Definitions.

(a) As used in this article:

(ix) "Service contract" means a contract for a separately stated consideration for specific duration to perform the repair, replacement or maintenance of property or indemnification for repair, or maintenance, for replacement the operational structural failure due to a defect in materials workmanship or normal wear and tear, with or without additional provision for incidental payment or indemnity under limited circumstances, including, but not limited to, Service towing, rental and emergency road service. contracts may provide for the repair, replacement maintenance of property for damage resulting from power surges and accidental damage from handling. + "Service contract" also includes a contract or agreement for one (1) or more of the following:

creases that can be repaired using the process of paintless dent removal without affecting the existing paint finish and without replacing vehicle body panels or sanding, bonding or painting;

tires or wheels damaged as a result of coming into contact with ordinary road hazards including, but not limited to, potholes, curbs, rocks, wood debris, metal parts, glass, plastic or composite scraps. A contract or agreement meeting the definition set forth in this subparagraph in which the party obligated to perform is either a tire or wheel manufacturer or a motor vehicle manufacturer is exempt from the requirements of this chapter;

chips or cracks but which expressly excludes the replacement of the entire windshield;

interior components of a motor vehicle caused by wear and tear but which expressly excludes the replacement of any part or component of a motor vehicle's interior.
