A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to hospital privileges for health care
2 providers; modifying provisions relating to providers who
3 may be granted privileges; clarifying provisions for
4 hospital privileges; modifying the reasons for denial of
5 privileges; and providing for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 35-2-113 is amended to read:

10

11 **35-2-113. Doctors of medicine, osteopathy,**
12 **chiropractic, dentistry or podiatrists may practice in**
13 **public hospitals.**

15 Any hospital owned by the state, ~~or any a~~ hospital
16 district, county or city, ~~thereof,~~ and any hospital whose

1 support, either in whole or in part, is derived from public
2 funds, including funds from programs for the necessary
3 support of the poor, shall be open for practice to doctors
4 of medicine, doctors of osteopathy, doctors of
5 chiropractic, doctors of dentistry, advanced practice
6 nurses and podiatrists, who are licensed to practice
7 ~~medicine or surgery, chiropractic, dentistry or podiatry~~ in
8 this state. ~~Provided, however, that these~~ The hospitals by
9 appropriate bylaws shall promulgate reasonable and uniform
10 rules and regulations consistent with this section covering
11 staff admissions and staff privileges. Admission to medical
12 staff shall not be ~~predicated solely~~ denied based upon the
13 type of degree of the applicant and the governing body
14 shall consider the competency and character of each
15 applicant.

17 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2010.
