1 AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; prohibiting the use of electronic wireless communication devices for sending text 2 or electronic mail messages while operating a motor 3 vehicle; providing exceptions; providing definitions; 4 5 providing penalties; and providing for an effective date. 6 7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 8 Section 1. W.S. 31-5-237 is created to read: 9 10 31-5-237. Use of electronic wireless communication 11 devices for electronic messaging prohibited; exceptions; 12 penalties. 13 14 15 (a) No person shall operate a motor vehicle while 16 using an electronic wireless communication device to write,

send or read a text-based communication. This section shall 1 2 not apply to a person who is using the electronic wireless 3 communication device: 4 While the vehicle is lawfully parked; 5 (i) 6 7 To contact an emergency response vehicle; or (ii) 8 9 (iii) read, То write, select or enter а 10 telephone number or name in an electronic wireless 11 communications device for the purpose of making or 12 receiving a telephone call. 13 14 (b) This section shall not apply to a person operating 15 an emergency response vehicle or while performing official 16 duties as an emergency responder. 17 18 Any person who operates a motor vehicle (C) in 19 violation of this section shall be subject to the monetary penalties provided by W.S. 31-5-1201(b). 20 21 22 (d) As used in this section: 23 (i) "Electronic wireless communication device" 24 means a mobile communication device that uses short-wave 25 26 analoq digital radio transmissions or satellite or

transmissions between the device and a transmitter to permit 1 2 wireless telephone communications to and from the user of the device within a specified area; 3 4 5 (ii) "Emergency response vehicle" means any 6 ambulance, fire department, law enforcement or civil defense 7 vehicle or other vehicle used primarily for emergency 8 purposes; 9 (iii) "Write, send or read a text-based 10 an electronic wireless means using 11 communication" 12 communications device to manually communicate with any person using text-based communication including, but not 13 limited to, communications referred to as a text message, 14 instant message or electronic mail. 15 16 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2010. 17 18 19 (END)
