(b) A person convicted of a nonviolent felony or 1 2 nonviolent felonies arising out of the same occurrence or 3 related course of events may apply in writing to the state 4 board of parole for a certificate which restores the 5 person's voting rights lost pursuant to W.S. 6-10-106. application shall specifically state that the requirements 6 7 of this subsection have been met and shall be on a form approved by the state board of parole. The state board of 8 9 parole shall issue a certificate restoring a person's 10 voting rights if: 11 12 (i) The applicant has never been convicted of 13 any other felony other than convictions arising out of the 14 same occurrence for which restoration of rights is sought; 15 and 16 17 (ii) All of the applicant's terms of sentence 18 are expired, or in the case of probation, the applicant has 19 completed all probation periods.; and 20 21 **Section 2.** W.S. 7-13-105(b)(iii) is repealed. 22
