1 (ii) A vehicle shall not be moved from the a 2 lane until the driver has first ascertained that the 3 movement can be made with safety; 4 5 (iii) (iii) Upon a roadway which is divided into three (3) lanes and provides for two-way movement of 6 traffic, a vehicle shall not be driven in the center lane 7 except when overtaking and passing another vehicle 8 9 traveling in the same direction when the center lane is clear of traffic within a safe distance, or in preparation 10 11 for making or completing a left turn or where the center lane is at the time allocated exclusively to traffic moving 12 in the direction the vehicle is proceeding and the 13 allocation is designated by official traffic-control 14 devices; 15 16 (iii) (iv) Official traffic-control devices may 17 be erected directing specified traffic to use a designated 18 lane or designating those lanes to be used by traffic 19 moving in a particular direction regardless of the center 20 21 of the roadway and drivers of vehicles shall obey the 22 directions of every such device; 23
