A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to condemnation; limiting the exercise of 2 the power of condemnation for commercial facilities
- 3 generating electricity from wind and for associated
- 4 collector systems; providing compensation standards for
- 5 condemned property as specified; requiring proof of
- 6 compliance; repealing an existing moratorium; and providing
- 7 for an effective date.

9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 11 **Section 1.** W.S. 1-26-715 and 1-26-818 are created to
- 12 read:

13

- 14 1-26-715. Compensation for commercial facilities
- 15 generating electricity from wind and collector systems.

16

- 1 Compensation related to the condemnation of property for
- 2 the construction of commercial facilities generating
- 3 electricity from wind and for associated collector systems
- 4 shall be made pursuant to W.S. 1-26-818.

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- 6 1-26-818. Right of eminent domain granted; wind
- 7 energy facilities and collector systems.

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- 9 (a) No person shall exercise the condemnation
- 10 authority granted by W.S. 1-26-815 for the erection,
- 11 placement or expansion of commercial facilities generating
- 12 electricity from wind, nor for collector systems associated
- 13 with commercial facilities generating electricity from
- 14 wind, without complying with this section.

15

- 16 (b) Before any person to whom subsection (a) of this
- 17 section applies may exercise the power of eminent domain,
- 18 the person shall:

19

- 20 (i) Negotiate land use and compensation
- 21 agreements:

22

- 23 (A) Which will grant the person the right
- 24 to occupy and use not less than eighty-five percent (85%)

1 of the land upon which the commercial facilities generating

2 electricity from wind and any associated collector system

3 will be constructed; or

4

5 (B) With not less than eighty-five percent

6 (85%) of the owners of land upon which the commercial

7 facilities generating electricity from wind and any

8 associated collector system will be constructed.

9

10 (ii) Allege in any complaint for condemnation

11 and provide proof to a court of competent jurisdiction

12 compliance with paragraph (i) of this subsection;

13

14 (iii) Allege in any complaint for condemnation

15 and provide proof to a court of competent jurisdiction the

16 average terms and considerations, monetary and otherwise,

17 granted to the owners of property with whom the person

18 negotiated under paragraph (i) of this subsection; and

19

20 (iv) Allege in any complaint for condemnation

21 and provide proof to a court of competent jurisdiction that

22 the commercial facilities generating electricity from wind

23 and any associated collector system for which the

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1 condemnation action has been filed constitute an

2 economically, legally and logistically viable project.

3

- 4 (c) In any condemnation allowed under this section,
- 5 the person whose land is condemned shall be compensated
- 6 with consideration that is equal to the average
- 7 consideration, monetary and otherwise, paid to the owners
- 8 of land with whom the condemner negotiated under paragraph
- 9 (a)(i) of this section.

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- 11 (d) This section shall not apply to a public utility
- 12 that has been granted a certificate of public convenience
- 13 and necessity pursuant to W.S. 37-2-205.

14

15 (e) As used in this section:

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- 17 (i) "Commercial facility generating electricity
- 18 from wind" means a facility which meets the requirements of
- 19 W.S. 35-12-102(a)(vii)(E) and (F);

20

- 21 (ii) "Collector systems associated with
- 22 commercial facilities generating electricity from wind"
- 23 means the conductor infrastructure, including conductors,
- 24 towers, substations, switchgear and other components

- 1 necessary to deliver power from any commercial facility
- 2 generating electricity from wind up to but not including
- 3 electric substations or interconnections facilities
- 4 associated with existing or proposed transmission lines
- 5 that serve load or that export energy from Wyoming.

- 7 **Section 2.** W.S. 1-26-815 by creating a new subsection
- 8 (e) is amended to read:

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- 10 1-26-815. Right of eminent domain granted; ways of
- 11 necessity for authorized businesses; purposes; extent.

12

- 13 (e) No person qualified to exercise the condemnation
- 14 authority granted by this section, except a public utility
- 15 that has been granted a certificate of public convenience
- 16 and necessity pursuant to W.S. 37-2-205, shall exercise the
- 17 authority for the erection, placement or expansion of
- 18 commercial facilities generating electricity from wind, nor
- 19 for collector systems associated with commercial facilities
- 20 generating electricity from wind other than as provided by

21 W.S. 1-26-818.

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23 **Section 3**. W.S. 1-26-815(d) is repealed.

1 Section 4. This act is effective immediately upon

2 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

3 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

4 Constitution.
