AN ACT relating to marriage; providing that marriages other 1 than of a male and a female person are void; providing that 2 marriages between more than two parties are void; providing 3 that marriages and domestic civil unions which would be 4 void if contracted in Wyoming shall not be given effect in 5 6 Wyoming; and providing for an effective date. 7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 8 9 Section 1. 6	married persons and spouses, whether they derive from
7	statute, administrative rule, policy, common law or any
8	other source of civil or criminal law.

Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon 10 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 11 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 12 Constitution. 13
