an employer to refuse to hire, 1 (i) For to 2 discharge, to promote or demote, or to discriminate 3 matters of compensation or the terms, conditions 4 privileges of employment against, a qualified disabled 5 person or any person otherwise qualified, because of age, sex, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry or 6 7 pregnancy, or to discriminate or retaliate against any person for having opposed any employment practice made 8 9 unlawful under this section or for having made a charge, testified, assisted or participated in any manner in an 10 11 investigation, proceeding or hearing under this act;

13 (ii) For a person, an employment agency, a labor organization, or its employees or members, to discriminate 14 in matters of employment or membership against any person, 15 otherwise qualified, because of age, sex, race, creed, 16 17 color, national origin, ancestry or pregnancy, or a qualified disabled person, or to discriminate or retaliate 18 19 against any person for having opposed any employment 20 practice made unlawful under this section or for having 21 made a charge, testified, assisted or participated in any 22 manner in an investigation, proceeding or hearing under 23 this act;
