A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the use of wind-powered electricity at 2 state facilities; requiring Level I and Level II studies by 3 the state building commission; providing an appropriation; 4 and providing for an effective date.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

7

Pursuant to W.S. 9-5-108(a), the state 8 Section 1. building commission shall perform a Level I reconnaissance 9 study and Level II feasibility study for the construction 10 of wind-powered electrical generation facilities at the 11 Wyoming medium correctional institution at Torrington, 12 sufficient to provide one-half (1/2)13 Wyoming of the institution's total annual electrical needs. For purposes 14 of W.S. 9-5-108(a)(i)(B), the legislature has determined 15 the need for the project. For purposes of the financing 16

1 plan and reporting required by W.S. 9-5-108(a)(ii)(G) and 2 (J), the state building commission shall include and report 3 to the legislature the total estimated cost of 4 constructing, operating and maintaining the wind-powered 5 electrical generation facilities.

Section 2. There is appropriated two hundred thousand 7 dollars (\$200,000.00) from the general fund to 8 the 9 department of administration and information. This 10 appropriation shall be expended only for the purpose of conducting and reporting the Level I and Level II studies 11 required by Section 1 of this act. Notwithstanding any 12 13 other provision of law, this appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any other purpose and any 14 unexpended, unobligated funds remaining 15 from this 16 appropriation shall revert as provided by law. This 17 appropriation shall not be included in the department of administration and information's annual 2013-2014 standard 18 biennial budget request. 19
