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14	(e) Tax sales. The following shall apply:
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1 (iii) The following shall apply to the time and 2 place of sale, the purchasers, unsold property and the 3 certificate of purchase:

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5 (B) Any person who offers Sales shall be made by public auction, without appraisal, to the highest 6 bidder for cash whose bid is at least sufficient to pay the 7 amount of taxes, interest, penalties and costs including 8 9 charges provided by paragraph (ix) of this subsection due 10 on any real property. is considered the purchaser thereof. 11 The purchaser shall immediately pay the county treasurer all amounts due on the real property in the absence of 12 13 which the real property shall again be offered for sale and 14 the original purchaser disqualified. Any real property which cannot be sold for the amount of taxes, interest, 15 penalties and costs shall be bid in for the county by the 16 17 county treasurer. Real property bid in for the county shall be assessed each year and taxes placed thereon the 18 same as other real property but shall be placed on a 19 separate assessment roll and the valuation shall not be 20 21 included in the county valuation. A list of the property 22 shall be sent to the board on the first Monday in July for 23 statistical purposes;
