- 10 (iv), 27-9-105(a)(i) and (ii), 35-1-620(b)(viii),

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13 1-11-101. Qualifications of juror.

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A Wyoming veterans' commission is created within 4 5 the military department consisting of twelve (12) members, not less than one (1) of whom shall reside in each judicial 6 district identified in W.S. 5-3-101, appointed by the 7 staggered terms of three 8 governor for (3) 9 Commencing with initial appointments made in 2005, four (4) 10 members of the board shall be appointed for a term of one 11 (1) year, four (4) members for a term of two (2) years and four (4) members for a term of three (3) years. 12 13 thereafter shall be three (3) years and staggered with one-14 third (1/3) of the members' terms expiring each year. Appointments shall be made without regard to political 15 affiliation, sex, sexual orientation or gender identity, 16 17 religion or ethnic background. The governor may remove any member as provided in W.S. 9-1-202. A chairman shall be 18 elected by the commission from among its members and a new 19
