AN ACT relating to administration of the government; 1 2 creating the position within the governor's office of chief 3 financial officer for the department of health; specifying duties; authorizing restriction of department expenditures 4 specified; providing for contingent 5 reports; as transferring a corresponding position and funds from the 6 7 department of health; and providing for an effective date. 8 9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 10 11 Section 1. W.S. 9-1-224 and 9-2-127 are created to 12 read: 13 chief financial 14 9-1-224. Department of health 15 officer.

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2 There is created within the office of the (a) 3 governor a chief financial officer for the department of 4 health, who shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure 5 of the governor. 6 (b) The chief financial officer for the department of 7 health shall function as a financial and budgetary liaison 8 9 between the department of health and the governor, and shall carry out those duties specified in W.S. 9-2-127. 10 11 9-2-127. Chief financial officer; 12 duties and 13 responsibilities. 14 (a) The duties of the chief financial officer 15 appointed pursuant to W.S. 9-1-224 shall include: 16 17 (i) Oversight of revenues received 18 and expenditures made by each division, program, section, 19 20 subsection or other function within the department of 21 health; 22 (ii) Monitoring all department revenues 23 and expenditures to determine if, for each function 24 and 2

1 budgetary line item, funds appropriated or anticipated are 2 reasonably expected to be sufficient to meet expenditure 3 obligations for the balance of the applicable fiscal 4 period;

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6 (iii) Consulting with the department director 7 and other officials as necessary to monitor department 8 revenues and expenditures.

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10 The chief financial officer, with approval of the (b) 11 governor and in consultation with the department director, shall have the authority to restrict spending by any 12 13 department program or function to ensure that expenditures 14 remain within appropriated and other reasonably anticipated available funds for the balance of the applicable fiscal 15 The chief financial officer shall certify to the 16 period. 17 auditor and treasurer any exercise of the authority granted under this subsection, and shall specify the nature and 18 duration of the expenditure restriction. 19

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(c) The chief financial officer shall report immediately to the governor and within thirty (30) days to the joint appropriations interim committee if:

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8 Section 3. The position of chief financial officer 9 within the department of health is transferred to the 10 office of the governor and the department of health's 11 authorized full-time positions is reduced accordingly. All 12 appropriated funds associated with this position shall be 13 transferred to the office of the governor.

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15 Section 4. This act is effective immediately upon 16 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 17 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 18 Constitution.
