9 Section 1.

- 11 (a) There is appropriated seventy-five thousand
- 12 dollars (\$75,000.00) from the general fund to the board of
- 13 nursing. This appropriation shall be for the period
- 14 beginning with the effective date of this act and ending
- 15 June 30, 2012. This appropriation shall only be expended
- 16 for the purpose of upgrading the board of nursing's

computer system to enhance the quality and timeliness of 1 2 services provided by the board as follows: 3 4 (i) Forty-two thousand dollars (\$42,000.00) to 5 develop and implement an electronic, on-line system for submitting and considering applications for 6 initial licenses; 7 8 9 (ii) Eight thousand five hundred dollars (\$8,500.00) for internal KNurse system upgrades; 10 11 12 (iii) Six thousand five hundred dollars 13 (\$6,500.00) to improve an automated e-mailing system designed to enhance the board's communication with its 14 nursing population; 15 16 17 (iv) Eight thousand dollars (\$8,000.00) to provide electronic, on-line capability for licensees to 18 update current address, phone number, e-mail and other 19

personal information;

22 (v) Ten thousand five hundred dollars 23 (\$10,500.00) to develop an electronic document library for

1 the capture, storage, indexing and retrieval of nurse

4 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, this

5 appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any

6 other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds

7 remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided

8 by law on June 30, 2012.

10 (c) This appropriation shall not be included in the

11 board of nursing's standard 2013-2014 budget.

13 Section 2. The board of nursing shall provide a

14 report to the joint labor, health and social services

15 interim committee no later than November 1, 2011 with

16 respect to the expenditure of the appropriation provided by

17 this act and the development, functionality and use of the

18 systems and upgrades for which the appropriation has been

19 made.
