## A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to education; limiting eligibility for
- 2 Hathaway opportunity scholarships to attendance at a
- 3 community college as specified; specifying applicability;

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

- 9 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-16-1304(a)(i)(A), (B), (b) and (d)
- 10 and by creating new subsections (g) and (h) is amended to
- 11 read:

- 13 21-16-1304. Hathaway opportunity, performance and
- 14 honor scholarships.

1 (a) Any student who meets the criteria under W.S.

2 21-16-1303 is eligible to receive a scholarship to pursue a

3 degree or certificate as follows:

5 (i) With a minimum cumulative high school GPA of

6 2.50 and a composite ACT score of at least nineteen (19), a

7 Hathaway opportunity scholarship for:

8

9 (A) Eight hundred dollars (\$800.00) per

10 semester at an eligible institution as provided in

11 subsection (b) of this section if enrolled for twelve (12)

12 or more semester hours;

13

14 (B) The amount provided under subparagraph

15 (A) of this paragraph times a fraction, the numerator of

16 which is the number of hours for which the student is

17 enrolled and the denominator is twelve (12), if enrolled at

18 an eliqible institution as provided in subsection (b) of

19 this section for at least six (6) and less than twelve (12)

20 semester hours.

22 (b) Scholarships under this section shall be for a

23 maximum of the equivalent of eight (8) full-time semesters.

24 A scholarship under this section shall be available for

1 attendance at a Wyoming community college for not more than

2 a maximum of the equivalent of four (4) full-time

3 semesters. An opportunity scholarship shall be available

4 only for attendance at a Wyoming community college from

5 initial eligibility for the scholarship until the student

6 has successfully completed at least thirty (30) semester

7 hours at an eligible institution.

8

9 (d) A student receiving a Hathaway honor scholarship or a Hathaway performance scholarship who fails to meet the 10 11 requirements of subsection (C) of this GPA necessary to maintain that scholarship may be awarded a 12 13 Hathaway opportunity scholarship for attendance at institution 14 appropriate eligible if he meets the requirements necessary to maintain that scholarship. 15 As used in this subsection "appropriate eligible institution" 16 17 means a Wyoming community college until the student has successfully completed at least thirty (30) semester hours, 18 19 except that if the student was enrolled at the university at the time he failed to meet the GPA requirements 20 21 "appropriate eligible institution" shall include the

university and a Wyoming community college.

1 (g) An opportunity scholarship reinstated pursuant to subsection (f) of this section shall be available only for 2 3 attendance at a Wyoming community college until the student 4 has successfully completed at least thirty (30) semester 5 hours. 6 7 (h) Any student who meets the criteria under W.S. 21-16-1303 and is eligible to receive a Hathaway 8 opportunity scholarship under paragraph (a)(i) or 9 subsection (d) of this section shall be eligible to use 10 11 that scholarship at the University of Wyoming as provided in this subsection. Once admitted to the University of 12 Wyoming under this subsection, an eligible student shall 13 14 not be required to enroll at the community college if he continues to meet all applicable requirements of this 15 article. Any student who meets the criteria under W.S. 16 17 21-16-1303 and is eligible to receive a Hathaway opportunity scholarship under paragraph (a) (i) or 18 19 subsection (d) of this section shall be eligible to use that scholarship at the University of Wyoming if: 20 21 22 (i) The registrar of records at the community 23 college in the closest geographic proximity to the eligible

student's residence certifies that the eligible student is
