Game & fish-pioneer licenses.

## A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to game and fish; providing for issuance of  
2 pioneer licenses based on collective years of residency;  
3 and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 23-1-705(d), (e)(i) and (ii) is  
8 amended to read:

9

10 **23-1-705. Complimentary licenses; one-shot antelope**  
11 **hunt licenses; gunpowder and buckskin hunt licenses;**  
12 **gratuitous licenses.**

13

14 (d) The department shall issue without charge  
15 lifetime bird, small game and fish licenses to any resident  
16 or honorably discharged veteran who is over sixty-five (65)  
17 years and who has ~~continuously~~ resided in Wyoming for at

1 least ~~the~~ thirty (30) years, ~~immediately preceding~~  
2 ~~application for the license,~~ or to any disabled veteran who  
3 is one hundred percent (100%) disabled as determined by the  
4 United States department of veteran affairs. The license  
5 is valid so long as the licensee remains a Wyoming  
6 resident.

7  
8 (e) The department shall issue:

9  
10 (i) For a fee of two dollars (\$2.00) a resident  
11 deer or antelope license and for a fee of five dollars  
12 (\$5.00) an elk license to any resident who was born on or  
13 before January 1, 1930, and who has ~~continuously~~  
14 Wyoming for at least ~~the~~ forty (40) years, ~~immediately~~  
15 ~~preceding application for the license, and~~

16  
17 (ii) For a fee established by rule of the  
18 commission a resident deer, antelope or elk license to any  
19 resident who was born after January 1, 1930, is at least  
20 seventy (70) years of age prior to the issuance of the  
21 license and has ~~continuously~~  
22 least fifty (50) years, ~~immediately preceding application~~  
23 ~~for the license.~~ The fee established for a license under  
24 this paragraph shall be not more than sixty-five percent

1 (65%) nor less than sixty percent (60%) of the resident fee  
2 specified in W.S. 23-2-101 for the particular species;

4 **Section 2.** This act is effective January 1, 2011.
