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Within forty-five (45) days from the date of 1 2 completion of the hearing the council shall make complete 3 findings, issue an opinion and render a decision upon the 4 record, either granting or denying the application 5 filed, or granting it upon terms, conditions or modifications of the construction, operation or maintenance 6 of the facility as the council deems appropriate. The 7 council shall not consider the imposition of conditions 8 9 which address impacts within the area of jurisdiction of any other regulatory agency in this state as described in 10 the information provided in W.S. 35-12-110(b), unless the 11 regulatory agency requests that conditions 12 other The council may consider direct or cumulative 13 impacts not within the area of jurisdiction of another 14 regulatory agency in this state. The council shall grant a 15 permit either as proposed or as modified by the council if 16 17 it finds and determines that:
