1 A JOINT RESOLUTION proposing to amend the Wyoming 2 Constitution by creating a new section specifying that a

3 marriage between a man and a woman shall be the only

4 domestic legal union that shall be valid or recognized in

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING,

8 two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting

9 separately, concurring therein:

11 **Section 1.** The following proposal to amend Wyoming 12 Constitution, Article 1, by creating a new Section 38 is

13 proposed for submission to the electors of the State of

14 Wyoming at the next general election for approval or

- 1 rejection to become valid as a part of the Constitution if
- 2 ratified by a majority of the electors at the election:

4 Article 1, Section 38. Marriages recognized.

5

- 6 Only a marriage between a man and a woman is valid or
- 7 recognized in Wyoming. The legislature may define the
- 8 benefits and obligations of marriage which may be different
- 9 than the benefits and obligations afforded to all other
- 10 civil relationships.

11

- 12 Section 2. That the Secretary of State shall endorse
- 13 the following statement on the proposed amendment:

14

- 15 The adoption of this amendment would affirm that only a
- 16 marriage between a man and a woman is valid or recognized
- 17 in Wyoming. The legislature may define the benefits and
- 18 obligations of marriage which may be different than the
- 19 benefits and obligations afforded to all other civil
- 20 relationships.
