Change of use for irrigation districts.

A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to the amendment of certificates of
- 2 appropriation; modifying the conditions under which a
- 3 change in use and change in place of use may be obtained;
- 4 providing for change in use or place of use within legally
- 5 organized conservancy and irrigation districts; and
- 6 providing for an effective date.

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8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 10 **Section 1.** W.S. 41-3-104(a)(intro) and 41-4-514(d)
- 11 are amended to read:

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13 41-3-104. Procedure to change use or place of use.

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- 15 (a) Except as provided in W.S. 41-4-514, when an
- 16 owner of a water right wishes to change a water right from

1 its present use to another use, or from the place of use under the existing right to a new place of use, he shall 2 file a petition requesting permission to make such a 3 change. The petition shall set forth all pertinent facts 4 5 about the existing use and the proposed change in use, or, where a change in place of use is requested, all pertinent 6 information about the existing place of use 7 and proposed place of use. The board may require that 8 9 advertised public hearing or hearings be held at the 10 petitioner's expense. The petitioner shall provide 11 transcript of the public hearing to the board. The change in use, or change in place of use, may be allowed, provided 12 13 that the quantity of water transferred by the granting of petition shall not exceed the amount of 14 historically diverted under the existing use, nor exceed 15 the historic rate of diversion under the existing use, nor 16 17 increase the historic amount consumptively used under the existing use, nor decrease the historic amount of return 18 flow, nor in any manner injure other existing lawful 19 appropriators. The board of control shall consider all 20 21 facts it believes pertinent to the transfer which may 22 include the following:

2 for amended certificate of appropriation; hearings on

3 petition; notice; costs.

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5 (d) The state board of control is authorized, upon written petition of the owner, to issue 6 certificates of appropriation for of water rights that have 7 been adjudicated for the purpose of correcting clerical 8 9 errors and when in the judgment of the board it appears or 10 to amend other provisions of the certificate as necessary. 11 The total amount of the appropriation of water shall not exceed the amount set forth in the original certificate of 12 13 appropriation and, in the case of an appropriation for irrigation use, the total area of the lands shall not 14 exceed the total area described in the original certificate 15 Except within legally organized 16 of appropriation. 17 conservancy or irrigation districts where the state board of control has determined in a contested case hearing, 18 19 conducted in accordance with its rules and the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act, that there is no injury to 20 21 the water rights of other Wyoming appropriators, the 22 amended area shall not exceed the area actually irrigated under the original water right. An owner of a water right 23 24 within a legally organized conservancy or irrigation

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1 district may obtain, under this section, an amendment of 2 the use or the place of use to another area within the 3 district notwithstanding the time limits established by W.S. 41-3-108. Any petitioner shall be the owner of all the 4 5 land involved in the petition, except that in cases where amendments are petitioned for in within a regularly legally 6 organized conservancy or irrigation district, the consent of 7 the district board and the consent or agreement of the land 8 9 owners directly involved is sufficient. Proper adjustments shall be made in any assessment levied against 10 11 affected by the amendment. The water rights of other Wyoming appropriators shall not be injuriously affected 12 13 thereby by the granting of an amended certificate of 14 appropriation. 15 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2012. 16 17
