Signs shall be posted at all entrances to the 1 (b) 2 building, or part of a building, which are secured as 3 specified in subsection (a) of this section. The signs shall be posted at a height of between five (5) and six (6) 4 5 feet above the ground or floor and positioned so as to provide an unobstructed view to those using the entrance to 6 the secured area. The signs shall be at least eight (8) 7 inches tall by ten (10) inches wide and shall contain the 8 9 following or substantially similar language: "Pursuant to W.S. 6-8-105, weapons are prohibited in this building 10 11 beyond this point. Violators are subject to criminal penalties." 12 13 (c) This section shall not apply to: 14 15 16 (i) officers while Peace enqaqed in the 17 performance of their official duties; 18 19 (ii) A person who has been specifically 20 authorized to carry or possess a firearm in the building, 21 or parts thereof, by the board of county commissioners of 22 the county in which the building is located or by any judge 23 operating in the building; or 24

(iii) Any part of the building which may be 1 2 entered without first passing through a secured entrance as described in subsection (a) of this section. 3 4 5 (d) Nothing in this section shall be construed to authorize the possession of a firearm anywhere where 6 prohibited by federal law or to authorize the possession of 7 a concealed firearm where prohibited by W.S. 6-8-104(t). 8 9 Any person carrying or possessing a firearm in 10 (e) violation of this section is quilty of a misdemeanor 11 punishable by a fine of not more than five hundred dollars 12 (\$500.00) for a first offense. A second or subsequent 13 offense shall be punishable by a fine of not more than 14 seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00), imprisonment in the 15 county jail for not more than six (6) months, or both. 16 17 As used in this section: 18 (f) 19 20 (i) "Building" building means a county 21 containing a district court or a circuit court;
