1 AN ACT relating to criminal trespass; specifying when  
2 knowledge is presumed; providing a definition; and  
3 providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 6-3-303 by creating new subsections  
8 (d) and (e) is amended to read:

9

10 **6-3-303. Criminal trespass; penalties.**

12 (d) A person is presumed to know that he is not  
13 authorized to enter on the land or premises of another if  
14 the person travels off of a public road and directly enters  
15 on private rural land without the permission of the owner  
16 or person in charge of the land. This subsection does not  
17 apply if a person travels directly to a residence or other

1 structure and immediately leaves the land or premises if  
2 permission to remain is not granted.

3

4 (e) As used in this section, "rural land" means land  
5 outside the boundaries of a city, town or platted  
6 subdivision.

7

8 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2012.
