- 13 (a) Any person who knows or has reasonable cause to
- 14 believe or suspect that a child has been abused or
- 15 neglected or who observes any child being subjected to
- 16 conditions or circumstances that would reasonably result in

1 abuse or neglect, shall immediately report it to the child

2 protective agency or local law enforcement agency or cause

3 a report to be made. Any person who knowingly fails to

4 make a report required by this subsection is guilty of a

5 misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than

6 one (1) year, a fine of not more than one thousand dollars

7 (\$1,000.00), or both.

9 (d) Any person who knowingly and intentionally makes

10 a false report of child abuse or neglect, or who encourages

11 or coerces another person to make a false report of child

12 abuse or neglect, is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by

13 imprisonment for not more than six (6) months one (1) year,

14 a fine of not more than seven hundred fifty dollars

15 $\frac{(\$750.00)}{(\$750.00)}$ one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), or both.
