for

1 AN ACT relating to higher education; requiring implementation of a day of student civic service by 2 institutions of higher education; requiring civic service 3 for continuation of Hathaway scholarships; providing for 4 5 loss and reinstatement of Hathaway scholarships accordingly; and providing for an effective date. 6 7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 8

10 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-16-1701 is created to read:

HIGHER EDUCATION CIVIC SERVICE PROGRAMS 13

21-16-1701. Wyoming civic service days. 15

1 The University of Wyoming and each Wyoming community

2 college shall establish one (1) or more Wyoming civic

3 service days to encourage students to perform charitable or

4 public service on the campuses of the institutions or

5 elsewhere in Wyoming. The civic service days shall take

6 place on Saturdays, each day to last at least six (6) hours

7 and shall commence in the 2012-2013 academic year. The

8 students who participate in the civic service days may be

9 high school, community college or university students.

"Civic service" shall 1 2 include work provided to a nonprofit or government 3 organization for charitable or public benefit purposes and may include programs, class activities and services 4 5 sponsored by an eligible institution which are not for credit nor part of an academic, vocational-technical or 6 continuing education program. 7 8 9 21-16-1304. Hathaway opportunity, performance and honor scholarships. 10 11 (c) To remain eligible for the scholarship under this 12 13 section, the student shall meet all of the following: 14 15 (ii) Except as provided in W.S. 21-16-1303(f) and subsection (f) of this section, maintain continuous 16 enrollment for not less than two (2) semesters in each 17 successive academic year. The department shall by rule and 18

regulation establish exceptions to the requirement of this
