A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to search and rescue operations; providing
- 2 immunity for volunteers as specified; repealing application
- 3 of the Governmental Claims Act and local government self-
- 4 insurance program to search and rescue operation
- 5 volunteers; and providing for an effective date.

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7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 9 **Section 1.** W.S. 1-1-125(a)(iii), (b)(intro), (i) and
- 10 (d) and 1-42-201(a) (vi) (intro) are amended to read:

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- 12 1-1-125. Immunity for volunteers; volunteer
- 13 firefighters.

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15 (a) As used in this section:

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(iii) "Volunteer" means an officer, director, 1 2 trustee or other person who performs services for a 3 nonprofit organization but does not receive compensation, 4 either directly or indirectly, for those services, or a 5 volunteer firefighter who performs services for a volunteer fire department under W.S. 35-9-601(h) whether or not he 6 receives compensation or a pension, or an individual 7 engaged in search and rescue operations under the 8 9 coordination of a county sheriff pursuant to W.S. 18-3-609(a)(iii) whether or not he receives compensation. 10 11 (b) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this 12 13 section, a volunteer who provides services or performs 14 duties on behalf of a nonprofit organization, or a volunteer fire department or a sheriff as part of a search 15 and rescue operation is personally immune from civil 16 17 liability for any act or omission resulting in damage or injury if at the time of the act or omission: 18 19 20 (i) The person was acting within the scope of 21 his duties as a volunteer for the nonprofit organization, 22 or volunteer fire department or a sheriff as part of a 23 search and rescue operation; and

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In any suit against a nonprofit organization, or 1 a volunteer fire department or a sheriff with respect to a 2 3 search and rescue operation for civil damages based upon the negligent act or omission of a volunteer, proof of the 4 5 act or omission shall be sufficient to establish the responsibility of the organization or department under the 6 doctrine of respondeat superior, notwithstanding 7 immunity granted to the volunteer with respect to any act 8 9 or omission included under subsection (b) of this section.

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11 **1-42-201.** Definitions.

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13 (a) As used in this act:

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(vi) "Public employee" means 15 any officer, employee or servant of a local government including elected 16 17 or appointed officials and persons acting on behalf or in service of the local government in any official capacity, 18 19 whether with without compensation., including or individuals engaged in search and rescue operations under 20 the coordination of a county sheriff pursuant to W.S. 21 22 18 3 609(a)(iii). "Public employee":

3 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

4 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
