A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming Pharmacy Act; authorizing
2 pharmacists to administer prescription medications as
3 specified; and providing for an effective date.

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5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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7 **Section 1.** W.S. 33-24-157 by creating a new
8 subsection (d) is amended to read:

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10 **33-24-157. Immunization and medication**
11 **administration.**

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13 (d) A pharmacist licensed under this act may
14 administer medications which can only be obtained by
15 prescription, subject to the following:

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1 (i) Patients shall be at least nineteen (19)
2 years old;

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4 (ii) Administration may be orally, topically,
5 intranasally or by injection;

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7 (iii) Administration shall be pursuant to a
8 prescription from a health care professional authorized by
9 law to write prescriptions for the medication being
10 administered;

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12 (iv) The board, in cooperation with the state
13 board of medicine, shall adopt rules specifying the
14 medications that pharmacists may administer and any other
15 reasonable limitations on administration of medications by
16 pharmacists.

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18 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2013.
