1 ownership as provided in subsection (a) of this section, if

2 the owner of the container notifies that person in writing

3 that he is the owner of the container and objects to that

4 person filling or refilling the container.

6 (d) Nothing in this section shall make it unlawful

7 for a manufacturer or supplier to place the name of the

8 manufacturer or supplier or other markings required by law

9 on a liquefied petroleum gas container.

11 (e) A violation of this section is a misdemeanor

12 punishable by a fine of not more than seven hundred fifty

dollars (\$750.00), imprisonment for not more than six (6)

14 months, or both.

16 (f) For purposes of this section, "liquefied

17 petroleum gas" means as defined in W.S. 40-7-102(a)(xiii).
