4 (b) department of state parks and cultural 5 resources through the division of state parks and historic sites shall in accordance with W.S. 36-4-123, appoint 6 selling agents to sell snowmobile registrations and user 7 Each selling agent shall may charge and retain an 8 9 additional one dollar (\$1.00) for each nonresident user fee sold under W.S. 31-2-409(a)(ii) or for each resident 10 11 registration sold under W.S. 31-2-404(a)(i). Designated department employees may sell snowmobile registrations and 12 13 user fees, but no employee shall receive any commission on registrations or user fees collected. 14

Except as hereafter provided, every person who 16 17 owns or uses a resident snowmobile which will be operated within the state of Wyoming shall, for each snowmobile so 18 owned or used file or cause to be filed each year beginning 19 20 July 1, with any designated registration selling agent, an 21 application for registration of the snowmobile which shall 22 be in writing in duplicate. The application shall state the name and address of the owner and the name of the 23 24 applicant and describe the snowmobile, including

model and any identifying serial numbers located on the 1 snowmobile. and whether the snowmobile will be operated for 2 3 private or commercial use. At the time of application, the 4 applicant shall also present proof in a form approved by 5 the department of revenue that all sales or use tax due on the snowmobile have been paid. Any person who knowingly 6 presents a false or fraudulent statement of proof is 7 subject to the provisions of W.S. 6 5 303, in addition to 8 9 any penalties and interest due for nonpayment of sales or 10 use tax on the snowmobile. 11 (e) Every person who owns or uses a nonresident 12 13 snowmobile which will be operated within this state shall, 14 for each snowmobile so owned or used, file or cause to be filed with a designated selling agent each year prior to 15 the operation within the state, an application under W.S. 16 17 31-2-409 which states the name and mailing address of the owner of the snowmobile and the name of the applicant. 18 19 20 31-2-403. Required resident snowmobile registration 21 fee.

The owner of a <u>resident</u> snowmobile which will be operated within the state of Wyoming shall, upon the filing of an

2	cash, money order, certified check or bank draft, a
3	registration fee as provided by W.S. 31-2-404.

2 together with a numbered decal which shall bear a

3 distinctive number assigned to the snowmobile and the date

4 of expiration, which shall at all times be prominently

5 displayed on the snowmobile.

In the event of loss, mutilation or destruction of any 10 11 registration resident or nonresident snowmobile's certificate issued pursuant to W.S. 31-2-401 through 12 13 31-2-409, or numbered decal, the owner of a snowmobile may obtain a duplicate registration certificate or a new 14 15 numbered decal from any registration selling agent or any authorized department of state parks and cultural resources 16 17 employee upon filing an affidavit showing the mutilation or destruction of the original registration 18 certificate or numbered decal and paying a fee of one 19 20 (\$1.00). The registration selling agent shall 21 forward which shall be forwarded to the division of parks and historic sites within the department fifty cents (\$.50) 22 of each duplicate registration certificate fee to be 23 24 deposited to the general fund snowmobile trails account
