7	(b) In addition to the penalties under subsection (a)
8	of this section, if the person convicted intentionally
9	causes a fire in violation of an order issued under this
10	article requiring a response by a paid or voluntary
11	firefighting unit the court shall order the person to pay
12	restitution to the governmental entity. Restitution
13	ordered under this subsection shall be for all or part of
14	the value of the services rendered by the responding
15	firefighting units. The court may consult with the state
16	forestor to ascertain the reasonable value of services. The
17	court shall not order restitution if the court finds the
18	person convicted has no ability to currently pay
19	restitution and there is no reasonable probability that the
20	person convicted will be able to pay restitution in the
21	future. The monies collected under this subsection shall be
22	paid to the fire suppression accounts of the governmental
23	entities that responded to the incident proportionally

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determined by the court and shall only be used for 1 2 firefighting purposes. 3 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2013. 4 5 6 (END)
