A BILL

for

AN ACT relating to school district capital construction 1 establishing a pilot program 2 funding; providing reimbursement to school districts for construction of 3 natural fueling facilities; allowing for 4 qas the reimbursement of buses fueled by natural gas; specifying 5 requirements; authorizing rulemaking; requiring reporting; 6 7 providing an appropriation; and providing for an effective 8 date.

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10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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12 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-13-320(f) is amended to read:

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- 14 21-13-320. Student transportation; amount within
- 15 school foundation program formula for transportation

 $1\,$ maintenance and operations expenditures and school bus

2 purchases; district reporting requirements.

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The department of education shall adopt necessary 4 5 rules and regulations to implement and enforce standards established under this section and to administer 6 section. District expenditures computed 7 subsection (b) of this section shall 8 not include 9 expenditures for employee contributions to the retirement system exceeding five and fifty-seven hundredths 10 percent (5.57%) of any member employee's 11 salary. department shall, in accordance with 12 addition, the 13 procedures prescribed by department rule and regulation, establish a base price for each school bus type or other 14 student transportation vehicle type for the applicable 15 fiscal period that complies with minimum state standards 16 17 for vehicle specifications and equipment. The department shall also establish a process including competitive 18 bidding which guarantees the acquisition of school buses 19 20 and other student transportation vehicles approved for 21 reimbursement and complying with state minimum standards and district fleet size restrictions at the established 22 23 base price for the applicable fiscal year. In addition and 24 for purposes of reimbursement under subsection (g) of this

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1	section, the department shall in consultation with the
2	pupil transportation committee, establish a minimum,
3	average and optimal replacement schedule for each school
4	bus type or other student transportation vehicle type_
5	including but not limited to buses fueled by compressed
6	natural gas. School districts shall notify the department
7	of school bus and other student transportation vehicle
8	needs and requirements for the appropriate fiscal year in
9	the manner and within the times prescribed by department
LO	rule and regulation, and shall report expenditures,
L1	purchases and lease arrangements for the applicable
L2	reporting period, including vehicles replaced by purchases
L3	and leases, as required by department rule and regulation.
L4	The department shall annually review and conduct audits as
L5	necessary of information submitted under this section. As
L6	authorized under W.S. 21-13-307(b), the department may
L7	correct the information reported by districts under this
L8	section as necessary to fairly and accurately reflect the
L9	data type, classification and format required to administer
20	this section in accordance with law and department rules
21	and regulations.

1 (a) The natural gas fueling facility pilot program

2 for Wyoming school districts is established. The school

3 facilities department shall reimburse school districts for

4 the construction of natural gas fueling facilities to be

5 utilized to fuel natural gas vehicles owned by the school

6 district in accordance with this act.

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8 (b) Each school district may apply to the school

9 facilities department for reimbursement for the

10 construction of a natural gas fueling facility in

11 accordance with this act and rules and regulations

12 promulgated by the school facilities department.

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14 (c) Application shall be on a form and in a manner

15 prescribed by the department. At a minimum, the

16 application shall include evidence that a natural gas

17 fueling facility is cost-effective as compared to

18 traditional fueling methods utilized by school districts.

19 The application shall include evidence that all funds

20 available by other means for construction of natural gas

21 fueling facilities have been applied for and the total

22 reimbursement shall be reduced to the extent amounts are

23 duplicative of any costs funded or paid for by other means.

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1 (d) The school facilities department shall notify

2 each district of its eligibility to submit an application

3 to be considered for reimbursement of costs of a natural

4 gas fueling facility. The department shall include

5 application requirements in the notification to the school

6 districts.

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8 (e) Not later than October 1, 2013, the school

9 facilities department shall report to the select committee

10 on school facilities on the pilot project. The report

11 shall include tabulation of construction costs and the

12 economic feasibility of the construction of natural gas

13 fueling facilities as compared to the costs of traditional

14 fueling methods.

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16 (f) Subject to amounts appropriated, funds shall be

17 awarded by the school facilities department to fund the

18 total cost for the construction of a natural gas fueling

19 facility meeting the requirements of this act and rules and

20 regulations adopted pursuant to this act. The amount

21 awarded shall be reduced to the extent the amounts are

22 duplicative of any costs funded or paid for by other means.

23 Funds shall be awarded on a first come, first served basis.

24 In the event additional funds are necessary to fully

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1 reimburse a school district for an approved project, the

- 2 school facilities department shall report the shortfall to
- 3 the select committee on school facilities.

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- 5 (g) Funding for the pilot program established under
- 6 this section shall be by appropriation of the legislature.
- 7 No school district shall be entitled to reimbursement from
- 8 any funds not specifically appropriated for purposes of
- 9 this act regardless of approval of, or partial
- 10 reimbursement for, the projects by the department.

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- 12 Section 3. For the period commencing on the effective
- 13 date of this act, there is appropriated twelve million
- 14 dollars (\$12,000,000.00) from the school capital
- 15 construction account to the school facilities department.
- 16 This appropriation shall only be expended for reimbursement
- 17 of school districts for construction of natural gas fueling
- 18 facilities in accordance with this act. Notwithstanding
- 19 any other provision of law, this appropriation shall not be
- 20 transferred or expended for any other purpose.
- 21 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any unexpended,
- 22 unobligated funds from this appropriation shall not revert
- 23 until further action of the legislature to revert the

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24 funds.

2 Section 4. This act is effective immediately upon

3 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

4 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

5 Constitution.
