- 8 and (B) is amended to read:

- 11 required.

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- 13 (a) All individual and group health insurance
- 14 policies providing coverage on an expense incurred basis,
- 15 individual and group service or indemnity type contracts
- 16 issued by any insurer including any nonprofit corporation

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1 and individual and group service contracts or certificates 2 issued by a health maintenance organization which provide 3 coverage for treatment of cancer or cardiovascular disease shall also provide coverage for routine patient care costs 4 5 which a policyholder or certificate holder, or his covered dependent, receives as part of a clinical trial or study 6 if: 7 8 9 (i) The medical treatment is provided in a phase II, phase III or phase IV study or clinical trial for the 10 treatment of cancer or cardiovascular disease; 11 12 13 (e) For purposes of this section: 14 (ii) "Routine patient care cost" means: 15 16 17 (A) A medical service or treatment that is a benefit under a health plan that would be covered if the 18 patient were receiving standard cancer or cardiovascular 19 disease treatment; or 20 21 22 (B) A drug provided to a patient during a cancer or cardiovascular disease clinical trial, other than 23 the drug that is the subject of the clinical trial, if the 24

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1 drug has been approved by the federal food and drug

2 administration for use in treating the patient's particular

3 condition.

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5 **Section 2.** The provisions of this act shall apply to

6 policies, contracts and certificates of insurance providing

7 coverage to any resident of this state that are delivered,

8 issued for delivery, continued or renewed after the

9 effective date of this act.
