A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to district courts, eliminating mandatory
2 transcription of specified criminal proceedings; and
3 providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 5-3-404 is amended to read:

8

9 **5-3-404. Criminal cases; reporting and transcript of**
10 **proceedings.**

12 The court reporter for criminal cases prosecuted in the
13 district court shall report all testimony and all
14 proceedings held in open court, except informal
15 discussions, informal instruction conferences and pretrial
16 conferences which shall be reported when requested by a

1 party. The reporter shall, within a reasonable time, at the
2 request of the court or any party, transcribe arraignment,
3 plea, change of plea and sentencing hearings and file the
4 transcript in the official court record.

6 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2013.
